

TITLE OF ABSTRACT (The title should accurately describe the questions answered by the study.)

Presenting Author's Name (underlined). Other author's names.

Authors' affiliated institution(s).

The scientific abstract should be a condensed and limited version of what could be contained in a full length paper. The length of the actual abstract must be no more than 1 printed page and must conform to the established margins (1 inch margin on top; 0.5 inch margins on the left, right, and bottom). All sections which follow these instructions should be printed in Times New Roman, 11 point font. Section headers should appear in bold, and the text which follows in each section should be unbold. The completed abstract should have a title, introduction, materials and methods, results, and **clinical/commercial application** section. Acknowledgements and references sections are optional. *Please submit a PDF version of the abstract and after acceptance please submit a PDF version of your poster. Further instructions will be provided after acceptance.*

Introduction: This section should include background information in order to introduce the current study, its importance to the literature, and its impact on society. The introduction should also clearly characterize the scientific question being investigated. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.

Materials and Methods: In this section authors can demonstrate how they have designed their study to address the questions presented in the Introduction. Materials and methods used in the study should be briefly explained in this section. For example, what essential reagents or instrumentation were used, what special techniques were applied and how, and what type of study was performed and any pertinent statistical techniques used. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.

Results and Discussion: This section should include a concise summary of significant positive and negative results. Please do not state "results will be presented" as it is uninformative and of little value. You can include up to one clearly labeled and captioned figure or table to support the presented results. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.

Figure 1. The figure caption should be written using Times New Roman, 10 point bold font.

Clinical/Commercial Application: The implications of the presented findings from a clinical or commercial stand-point must be concisely but clearly explained in this section. This section could also include recommendations for future studies. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.

Acknowledgements: (Optional) Please acknowledge people or funding sources who may have contributed to the successful completion of this research. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.

References: (Optional) This section may include any references to published literature. If it is necessary to cite references, insert the primary author's name and initials followed by the abbreviated journal title, the year of publication, the volume number, and the page numbers. This section should be written using Times New Roman, 11 point font.
