Dr. Robert Fischl passed away on Monday, February 5, 2018. Relatives and friends are invited Thursday beginning 9:15 am to Apath Emanu-El, 205 Elbo Lane, Mt. Laurel, NJ 08054 where funeral services will begin at 10:00 am. Following the service, interment will be at Crescent Memorial Park in Pennsauken, NJ.

He was husband of Ruth; brother of Doris (Meir) Usherowitz; father of Ellen Fischl-Bodner and Daniel (Lee Anne); grandfather of Abigail (Bar Guzi), Kate, Alexander, Benjamin and Gabriella; and great-grandfather of Micah Guzi.

Professor Fischl was the founder of the Center for Electric Power Engineering at Drexel University, he had over 40 years of experience in the field of electric power engineering. He was an IEEE Fellow for his contributions to the design and understanding of power systems.
