Visas Application

Please be advised AVANI Victoria Falls Resort does not have a visa waiver programme in place and that foreign passport holders are required to pay for their visas on arrival or to make arrangements for their own visas prior to departing depending on their nationality.

Following the above statement, please find fees applicable to all nationals:

- Single Entry – US\$50
- Double Entry – US\$80
- Transit Visa – US\$50
- Multiple Entry – US\$80 – These are only obtainable through Immigration headquarters (in Lusaka) or Zambia missions abroad prior to arrival.

AVANI Victoria Falls Resort will assist with visa applications and forward approval letters to ports of entry for nationals from referred visa countries who are still required to pay applicable visa fees on arrival. The visa approval letter is only a facilitation and not a visa waiver. Guests will still be required to pay the applicable visa fee.

Malaria

Zambia is in a Malaria area - Malaria is transmitted by Anopheles mosquitoes.

THE RISK OF MALARIA CAN BE GREATLY REDUCED WITH SOME SIMPLE PRECAUTIONS.

Prevention:

- Personal prevention
- Prophylactic drugs

Malaria mosquitoes only bite after dark. Personal prevention is the best protection against the malaria-infected mosquito.

- It is recommended to take preventative daily medication and spray mosquito repellent after dark.
- Sleep in an air-conditioned room or under a fan.
- Keep all windows and doors closed after dark.
- Wear long sleeves and trousers in the late afternoon and at night.
