PACE Projects - 2005

- Sections proposing PACE Projects:
 - Erie, Columbus (2), NOVA (4), Pittsburgh, Southern New Jersey (2), Philadelphia, Washington (4), Baltimore, Central PA
 - Projects include both MPACs and SPACs
 - \$11,115 of R2 PACE Budget allocated to date.
 - \$5,965 dispersed
 - \$5,150 committed
 - \$2,000 allocation from IEEE-USA used to support MPACs in Region 2
 - \$2,656 still to be allocated in 2005

- Budget - \$11,771

 - Project Proposals should be submitted ASAP
 - Final funding allocations will be determined, made by beginning of December
