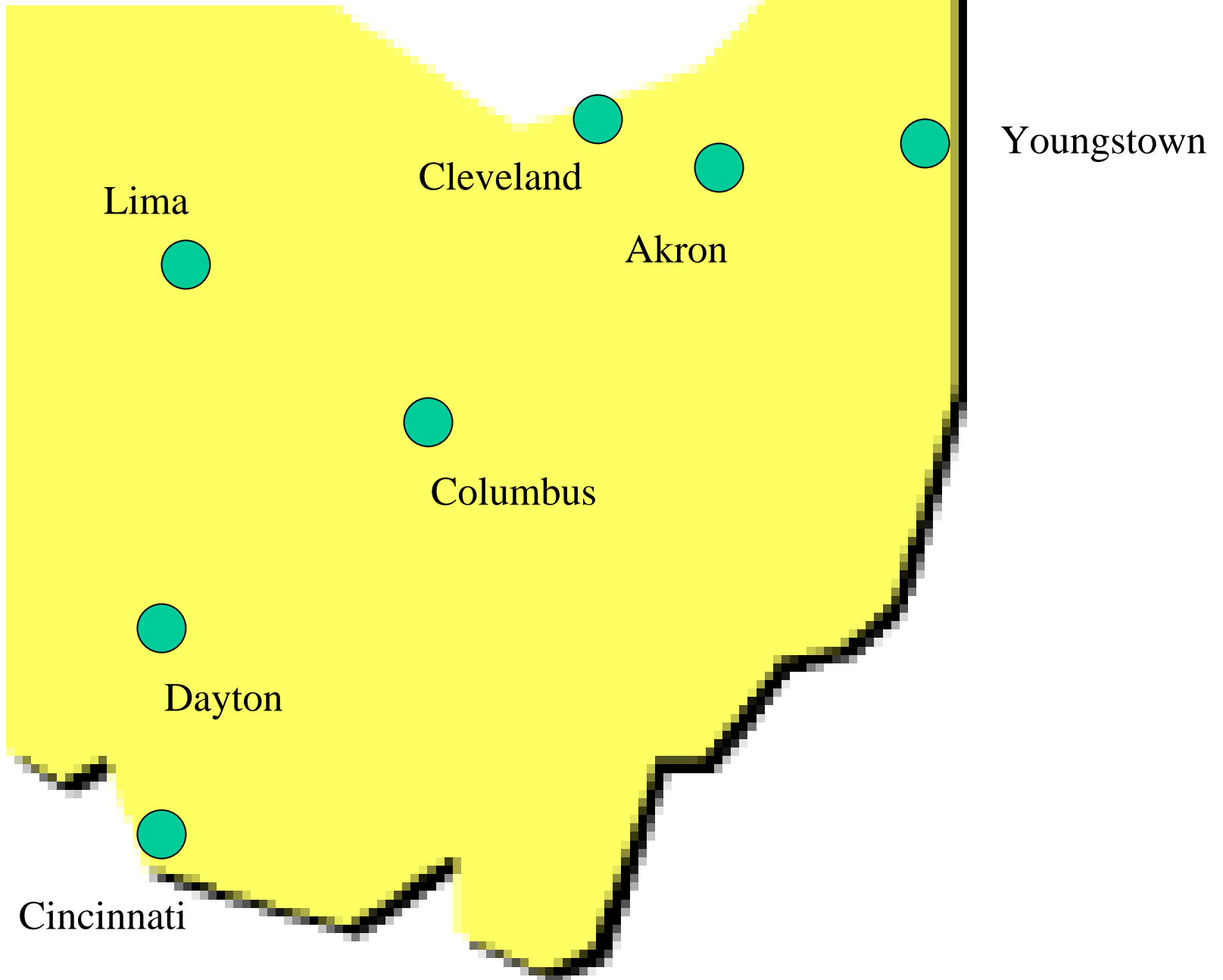
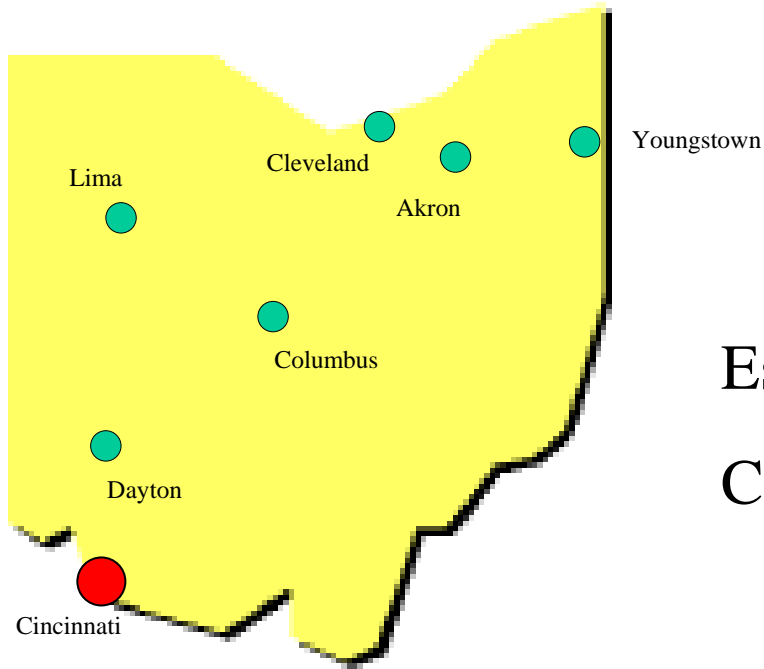

Cincinnati

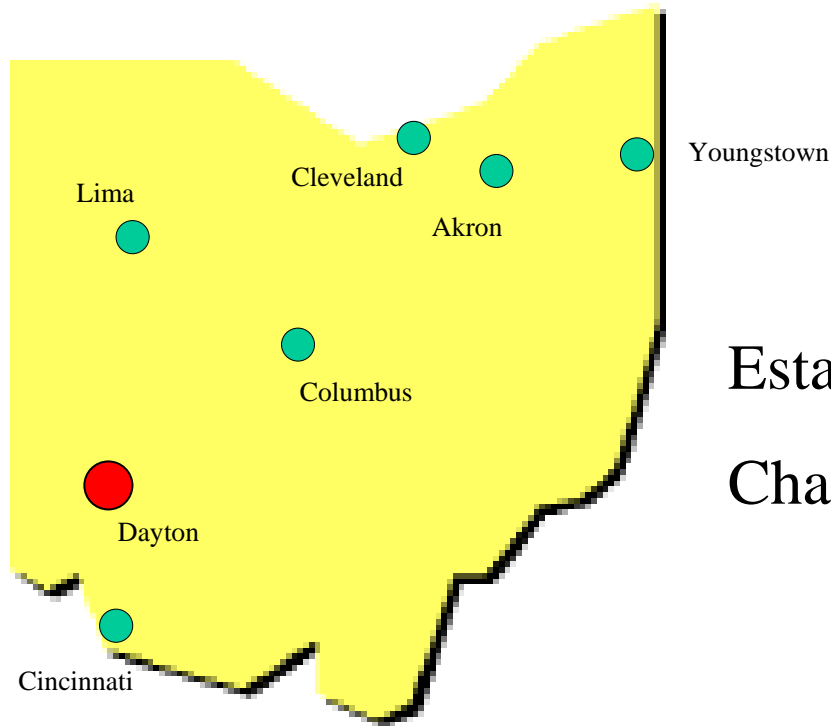

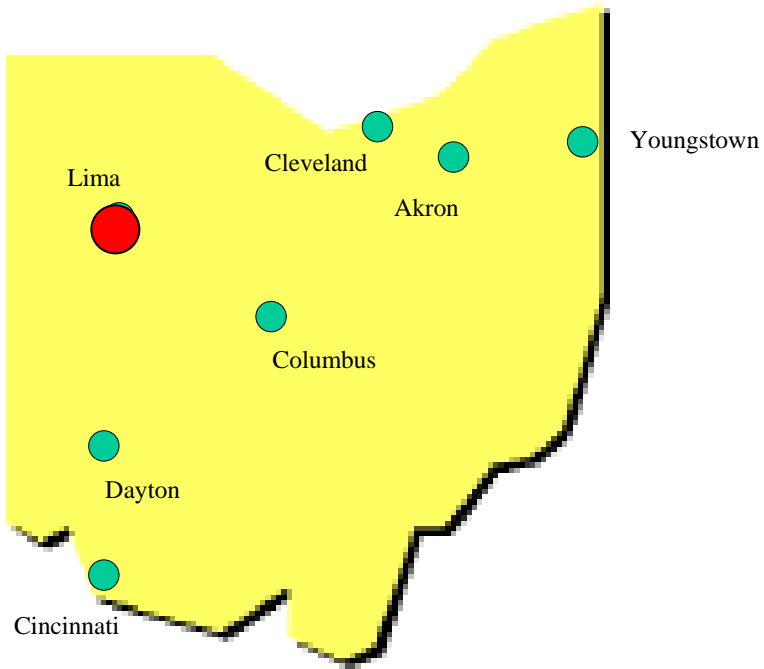
Dayton

Chair: Dennis Hoffman

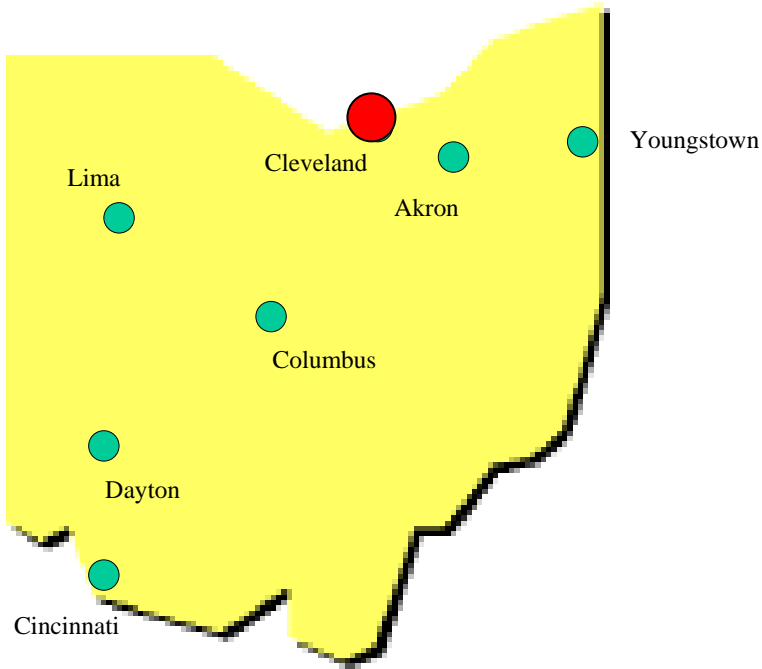
This is our smallest section. Dennis Hoffman attended the Sections Congress. They launched their section's web page.

Cleveland

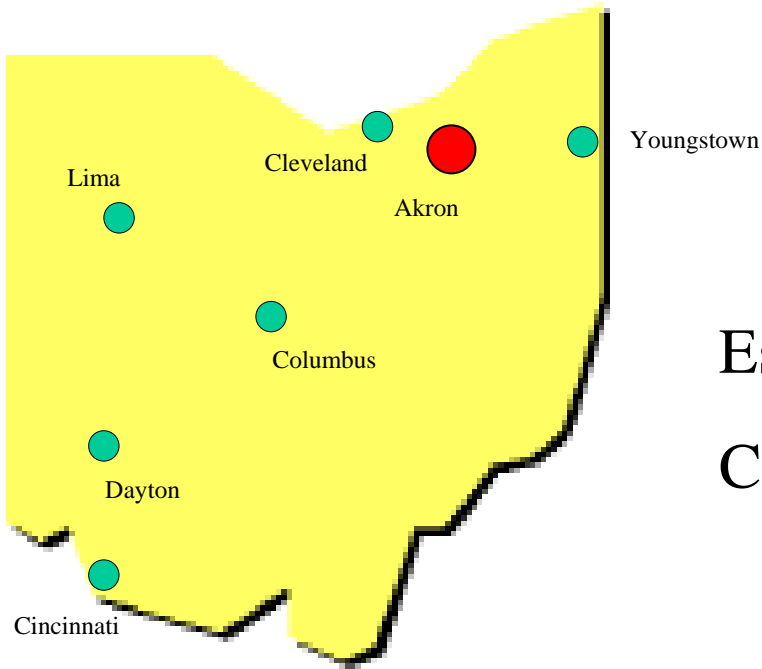

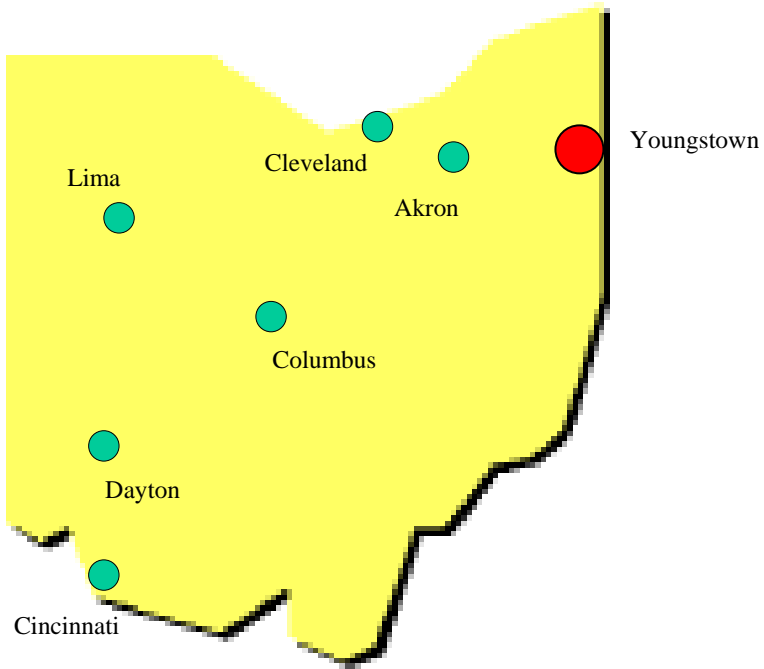
Akron

Youngstown

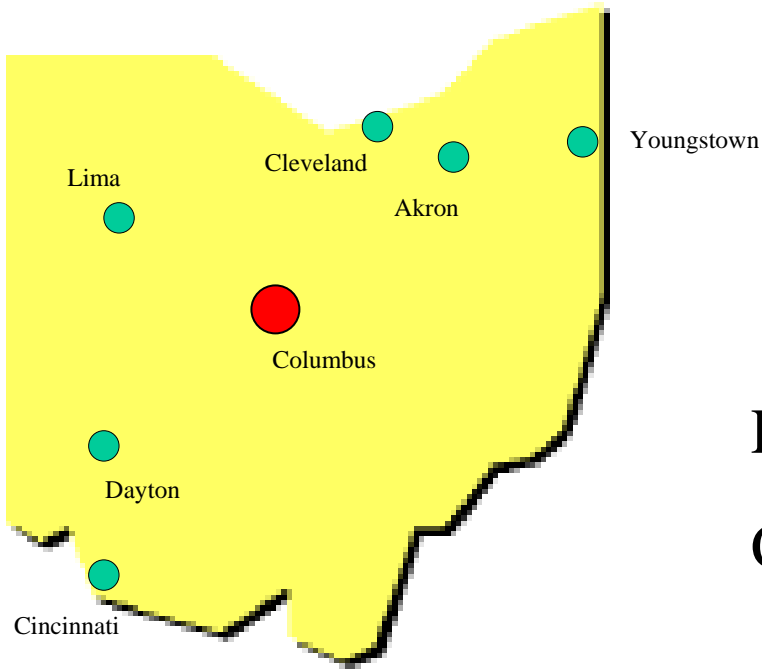
