

# TALKING POINTS FOR WEST BRANCH HIGH SCHOOL CHARTER

1. The Central Pennsylvania Section of the IEEE sponsors the Student Club under this charter.
2. The Central Pennsylvania Section shall be the primary source of Student Club's support for financial, organization and activities of the Student Club.
3. All membership information is kept by the School only. The School Counselor is the only person IEEE will have any record of and that is for sending information for the Student Club.
4. If West Branch High School / Central Pennsylvania Section want to recommend a Student for some recognition, then it must be sent by the School in accordance with the School's privacy regulations.
5. The Student Club will receive some copies of the Potentials Magazine for circulation among its members.
6. The student Club will work with the Central Pennsylvania Section of the IEEE in accordance with locally agreed on procedures.
7. The West Branch High School Counselor shall be a member of the IEEE and the annual dues will be paid by the Central Pennsylvania Section.
8. The Central Pennsylvania Section shall allocate funds to the Student Club for specific projects or activities at the School by its members.
9. Student Club must maintain a roster of at least 10 members at all times.

What can the Student Club do for the IEEE and IEEE can do for the Student Club?

1. Get IEEE members to serve as mentors for competitions such as robotics, LECO Science Fairs etc.
2. Job shadowing opportunities.
3. Create potential high school internship opportunities
4. Offer leadership opportunities for the members
5. Site Visits/Tours where IEEE members work such as Semiconductor chip manufacturing plants, electrical power stations, Variable Speed Drive manufacturing plants and Radio Transmission Towers etc.
6. Bring speakers to the Club for technology dissemination on a practical level.
7. Periodic lectures on what IEEE members do in their jobs (some show and tell videos about various career opportunities)
