 - A mechanism for communication of members' views on their professional needs.

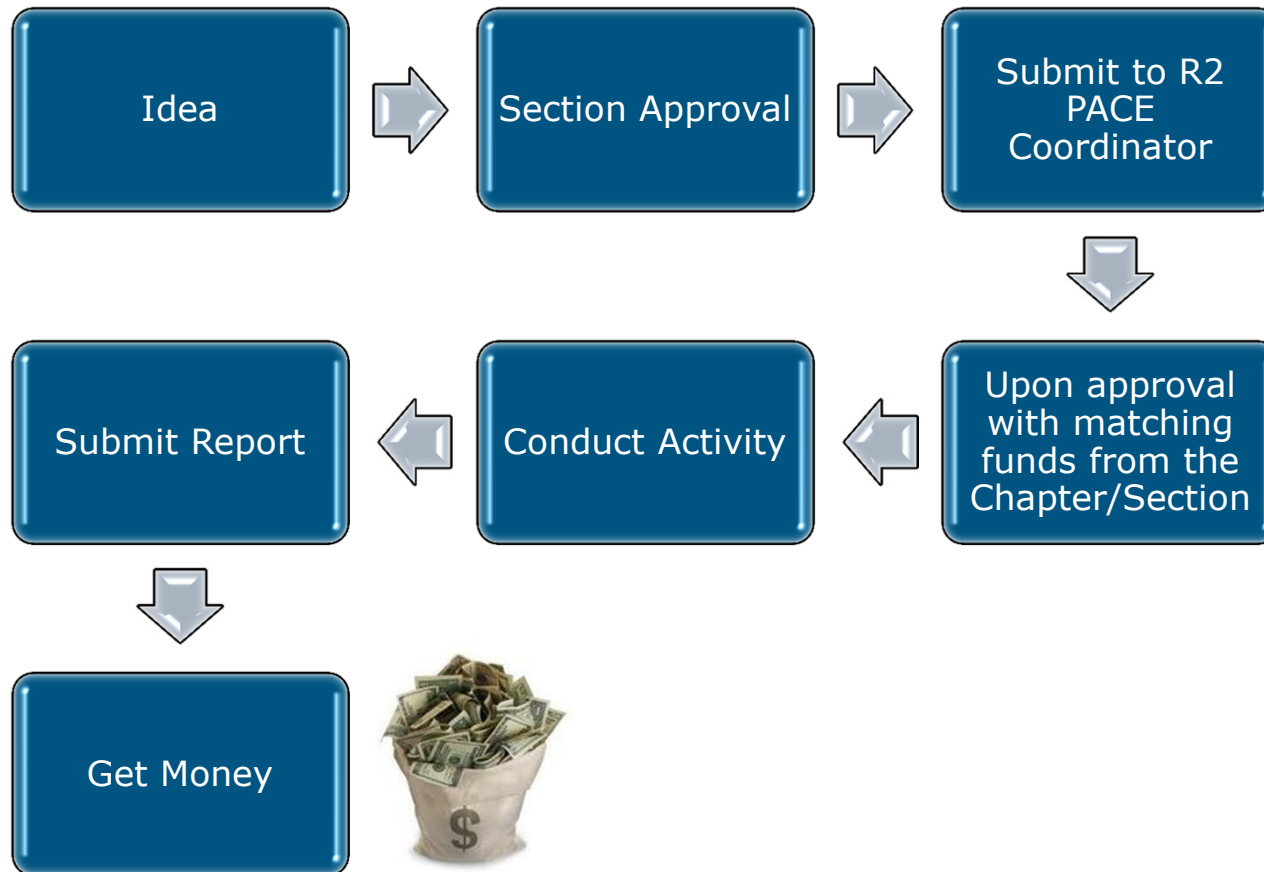

- Recommendation of PACE project funding
- Provide PACE training
- Support the Member Engagement Program (MEP)
- Participation in all IEEE-USA PACE committee activities
- Coordinated R2 participation at the IEEE-USA Annual Meeting.
- Disbursed all funding from IEEE-USA
- Over 22 total projects
- IEEE-USA 2013 fund disbursement dates were mid and end of the year
- Most sections submitted completion reports
 - Sections pending to complete a completion report have until 3/15/2014

Goals for 2014

- 100% Section Participation
- 10% growth in projects
- More efficient funds disbursement
