The Student poster awards will be given to the **three top presented posters**, as judged by the review committee. Authors wishing to participate in the poster session must submit a poster title and abstract (less than 150 words) at <https://ieeefluidsveys.com/s/posters/> no later than **April 21st, 2015**. The suggested poster size is 4 feet by 3 feet, and should contain large text to be read from a distance. Poster authors should attend and present their posters from 4:00PM to 5:15 PM during the Poster Session and Student Competition on the day of the conference.

There is **No registration fee limited to one for each poster submitted**. All the additional student authors for a particular poster needs to be registered as a Student Poster at the Registration link <https://meetings.vtools.ieee.org/m/32023> with a 25\$ Fee and every participant will receive a **Certificate of Participation** along with the top 3 winners of the competition.
